ISAC Subic - 2017 Boys' Soccer Tournament Rules

1. All soccer games will consist of two 20-minute halves with a 10-minute break at the half.
2. Warm ups must take place on the end field and teams should be ready to go before the previous game finishes.
3. Games will start as scheduled. A shot-gun start will only be used if games get behind schedule.
4. The team listed first on the schedule is designated as the "Home Team" and should wear a light colored uniform. Goal keepers must wear bright and contrasting colors that are not similar to either team.
5. The Nike Catalyst Team Ball will be used as the official game ball.
6. Unlimited substitution through the 4th official will be allowed when the subbing team has possession of the ball. The opposing team may also legally "piggy-back" substitute at that time. Any team may substitute when there is no advantage to the opponent for a quick re-start. (i.e. after a goal or injury)
7. A red card issued during any game will also make the player ineligible for the following game.
8. Any player who is given a red card for violent conduct will be ineligible for the teams' next two games.
9. Two yellow cards received in two different matches shall carry over and incur automatic suspension from the subsequent match.
10. In the regular round robin play draws will stand.
11. All cards will be reset at the beginning of the semi-final round.
12. Winning teams will receive three (3) tournament points, drawing teams - one (1), losers - zero (0); and forfeit – negative one (-1).
13. After the regular round-robin play, places will be determined, if need be, using the ISAC tie-break procedures:
 - ISAC Tiebreak Procedure:**
 - A. Head-to-head result
 - B. Goal Differential between tied teams
 - C. Goal Differential in all games
 - D. Goals Scored in all games
 - E. Goals Conceded in all games
 - F. Penalty Shoot-out
 - Notes:
 1. In a tie among more than 2 teams, once a team is promoted or demoted, then the procedure reverts back to head to head.
 2. In a tie among more than 2 teams, if 2 of the 3 teams are even at the top, then the bottom team is demoted and the tie break reverts back to head to head.
14. The semi-final and final games will be run according to the actual time schedule, not in a shotgun manner.
15. The 3rd Place and semi-final games will be run under the same time schedule as all other games. If however, they end in a tie they will proceed immediately to a standard penalty shoot-out.
16. If the final game ends at regulation time in a tie two complete five minute extra periods will be immediately added on, and if there is still no winner after extra time they will proceed immediately to a standard penalty shoot-out.
