Students may only start school 1 day after official enrolment. Cut off time is 12 noon

SUPPLIES & OTHERS

SCHOOL PACKET All students receive a school packet upon enrolment. ELC and Lower school student packets are delivered directly to the classrooms. MS and US students claim it from the bookstore.

LOCKERS

Middle and Upper school students will be assigned on their first day of classes through homeroom teachers.

USERNAMES AND EMAIL Students from 4th grade up will receive a BRENT email username and password which they will also use to log in the school database. This will be given on the first week of school.

MEDIA CENTER RESOURCES All students will have access to BISS libraries which is home to a large collection of books and online resources. The student ID is used to check out books.

STUDENT ID

A BISS Student ID is issued to all students at the beginning of the year. The ID has a unique barcode that is used to keep track of student accounts in the library and cafeteria. Parents may load a minimum amount of P500 to the ID card through the bookstore.

During the first week of school, new students are given :

- 5. Computer User name and password (Grade 4 & Up)
- 6. Schedules & Syllabus from teachers

RESERVATION FEE OF \$500 - Once accepted, you will have to pay this amount to the School Cashier to secure your child a slot for enrolment within the next 5 days. This amount will be deducted from the tuition fee.

1. FILL UP the Enrolment Registration card (included in your student packet)

2. SUBMIT the Registration Card to the Cashier The Cashier will give your exact assessment of school fees.

3. PAY the Tuition fee either for the whole year, or on a semester or quarter scheme . Other payment plans must be approved by the Headmaster in advance.

OTHERS:

All fees may be paid in USD or in the Peso equivalent on the day of the payment.

BUS FEES - All bus registration and payment may be done at the Cashier's office as well.
